# Gratitude Report

What a couple of unbelievable school years! With many ups and downs, it is more important than ever to take time to appreciate and recognize our generous donors. This gratitude report will serve as an account of the generosity bestowed on us.

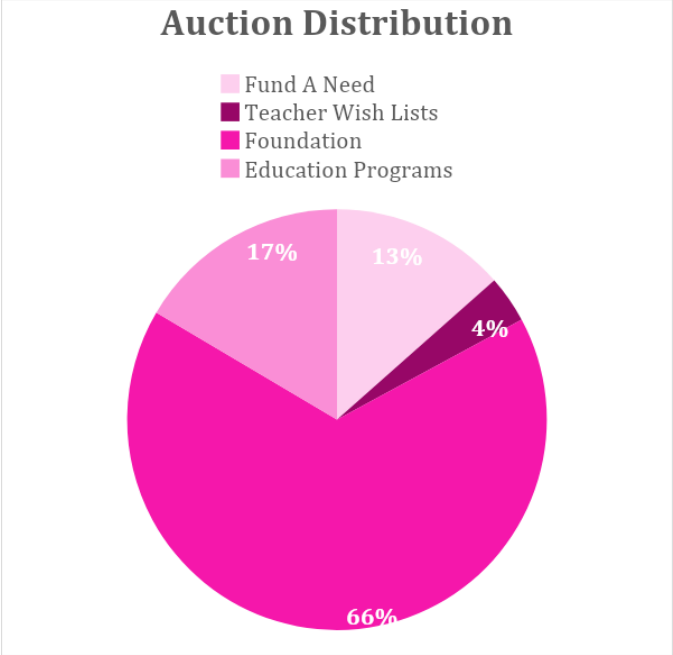
In the 1980's, community members of St. Anthony of Padua created a Foundation to indefinitely perpetuate financial investments with the sole purpose to create decades of Catholic Education! Since inception, the endowment continues to grow and benefit our community. Four percent of earned interest is distributed annually for improvements and new programs. The Auction for All is a source of contribution to the endowment on an annual basis, ensuring that years from now, children will have the same opportunities in our community that they do now. But, only a **portion** of money raised at Auction is distributed to the foundation.

Next, it is incredibly important to give gratitude to the St. Anthony of Padua Church community tithe practices. Our Parish commits **35%** of the overall funds that our community tithes directly to our educational programs! To offer perspective, of the 31 schools in our Diocese, 7 parishes commit zero tithe budget to their school or education programs. **ONLY TEN** other schools are at the same level as St. Anthony of Padua. The average parish commitment in our diocese is 27%. Thank you, for your tithe gift to our community and support that is committed to the school as a result.

Finally, it is important for us to share previous annual distribution efforts. This will be updated annually as we move forward to maintain transparency. The Auction Committee believes in the vision of creating long term perpetuating investment so our community will thrive when we are no longer here to see it. But only 66% of the funds raised become Endowment Foundation contributions. **Over 33% of our funds raised for Auction for All go directly to the education programs immediately impacting our community.**

Thank you, enjoy the night, and rest assured, we are building a COMMUNITY!

Good Evening Auction Supporters,

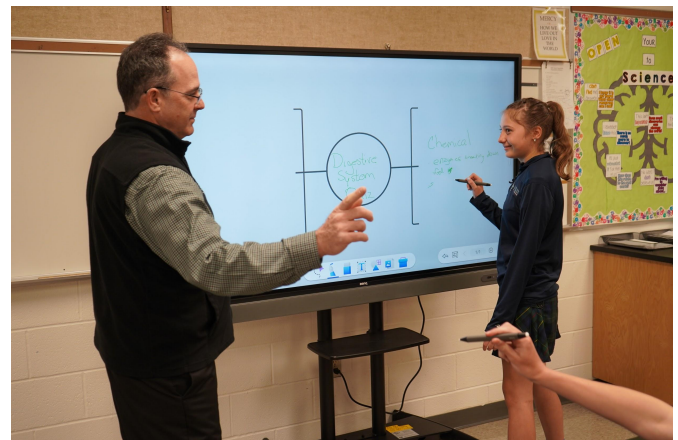
In my five years as principal, this is my third Auction. We've endured some unprecedented times, and as I look back over the last couple of years, the phrase "making lemonade out of lemons" comes to mind.

Here is a highlight of what we've accomplished financially:

- Technology lab remodel/conversion into our SmartLab, allowing for kindergarten through 8th grade students to have STEM class weekly.
- Library update and rebrand into the St. Anthony Media Center to promote group projects and studying while still allowing students to check out books and library resources.
- 1:1 devices for all students! 1st - 8th grade students access Chromebooks, while preschool and kindergarten have new iPads.



- Interactive Whiteboards are in every classroom as of 2022. Teachers are using these to increase student engagement in all lessons.
- Laptops that connect to our interactive white boards were purchased for staff.
- New classroom blinds funded through unAuction improving appearances while increasing safety.
- Through a generous donor and grant funds, we purchased Big Ideas math curriculum K-8. Math scores surpassed national averages in the first year



of implementation in all grade levels as measured by the NWEA MAPS test.

- A NEW backlit exterior sign and landscaping throughout the front of the campus.
- Student Prayer Garden garden in our courtyard funded through Sacred Grounds Garden grant.
- Behind the scenes, a new air conditioning unit in the middle school, wireless thermostats throughout the building, and upgraded plumbing.
- The parish and school upgraded to a new communication system in 2021.
- Increased safety with a keyless entry system, exterior cameras, and buzzer system in the school office.
- Over \$400,000 of St. Anthony school financial assistance provided to students and families.



As I see all that we have accomplished, it excites me to think about what the future holds. We have been blessed by strong supporters, the financial backing of our parish, and grant funding. Thank you for being a supporter of educational programming! Have fun, enjoy the company of those in our community, and keep education in mind as you bid tonight!

## Auction Information

Grab a refreshment and walk around to check out the Silent Auction tables, the Special Events tables and do not miss the opportunity to get in on great raffles and prizes. Many events and activities sell out early, so do not wait too long. If you have any questions, please see any one of our auction staff or an auction volunteer!

Review the lists and descriptions of items and services found in the catalog and on our Auction website. You will find Live Auction and Special Event descriptions in the catalog. Silent Auction items are listed but for full details see the online bidding website. The auction paddle you received has your bid number printed on it. Use this number for all of your bidding the entire night. Know what you are bidding on! The auction guidelines provide pertinent information for you. Use your bid number to purchase Special Events tickets/chances, and raffles. No cash is necessary – see the Check Out Procedure for details.

## Live Auction Rules

1. The LIVE auction will begin at 7:00 PM on November 12, 2022, and continue until all items have been auctioned. Doors will open at 5:00 PM for cocktails and to provide a time to view the various items up for bid.
2. The successful bidder will be charged for all items purchased during the evening of the auction. Statements will be emailed within 3 business days after auction. Bidders have until the close of business day on Monday, November 21st to discuss their charges with the business office. Bidders may pay their bill by cash, check, MasterCard, Visa, or American Express to the parish office during normal business hours or the credit card obtained at check-in will be billed accordingly on Tuesday, November 22nd.
3. A signature or oral bid constitutes a legal contract to buy. All sales are final, and there will be no exchanges or refunds on items except where specified.
4. During the Live Auction, bidders must hold up their bidding numbers to signify their bid. The auctioneer will determine the highest acceptable bid.
5. Successful bidders must sign an "Auction Receipt". Individuals should verify that the bid number, amount bid, and description of the item are correct.
6. Items should be removed that evening by showing a valid ID & signing for the item.
7. Any values set forth opposite items being auctioned are often donors' estimates and are not warranted by the auction for tax purposes or for general use.
8. Some items may be "upgraded" through the donor/supplier. All upgrades will be based on the stated "retail" value of the item. Bidders will receive no credit for payments made to the auction in excess of retail when seeking an upgrade.
9. Unless otherwise specified, all auctioned items and services must be used within one year after November 12, 2022. Offers from donors will expire on November 12, 2023.
10. All auction items must be removed by purchasers at their own expense from West Catholic High School or St. Anthony by Sunday, November 13, 2022.
11. The St. Anthony Auction Committee makes no expressed or implied warranties on auction items other than those from the manufacturer, which may be with the purchase.
