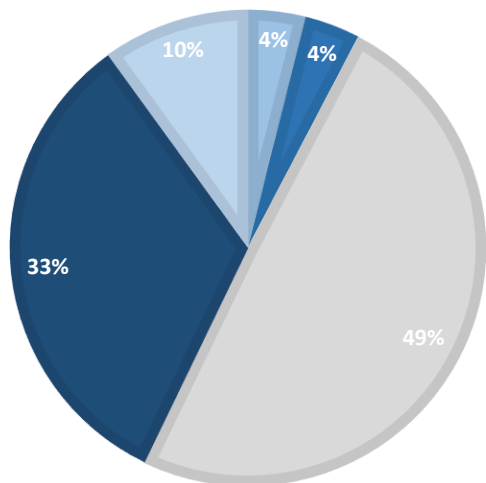
GRATITUDE REPORT

Even though our school routines feel back to what we are all accustomed to, our giving hearts and servant souls continue to provide for our community. It is time to recognize this generosity with this gratitude report. This will serve as an account of the generosity bestowed on us.

History: In the 1980's community members of St. Anthony of Padua created a Foundation to indefinitely perpetuate financial investments with the sole purpose to create decades of Catholic Education for our youth! Since inception, the endowment continues to grow and benefit our community. Four percent of earned interest is distributed annually for improvements and new programs. As the endowment grows, naturally the actual dollars of the four percent do as well. The Auction for All is a source of contribution to endowment on an annual basis, ensuring that years from now, children will have the same opportunities in our community that they do now. But, only a **portion** of the money raised at Auction is distributed to the foundation.

Did you know that our St. Anthony of Padua Parish commits **35%** of the overall funds that our community tithes directly to our educational programs? This is an amazing commitment. For perspective, of the 26 elementary schools in our Dioceses, 4 parishes commit zero tithe budget to their education programs. **ONLY THREE** other schools are the same level as St. Anthony of Padua. The average parish commitment in our dioceses is 22%. Thank you, for your tithe gift to our community and support that is committed programs to the education programs as a result.

Finally, it is important to share previous annual distribution efforts. This will continue to be updated annually as move forward to maintain transparency. The Auction Committee believes in the vision of creating long term perpetuating investment so our community will thrive when we are no longer here to see it. We saw an amazing shift with 49% of our community giving during

Auction for All supporting the Fund A Need. Yet, we still invested 33% into our Foundation. **Over 66% of our funds raised for Auction for All went directly to the programs and improvements that immediately impacted our community!**

Thank you, enjoy the night, and rest assured, we are building a COMMUNITY!

Good Evening Auction Supporters,

This is one of my favorite nights of the year - the anticipation leading up to it is a lot of work, but it is so great to come together as a community for a great cause and lots of FUN! Thank you for being here tonight and for the support that you continue to give to our school and parish community. You are valued - your financial support and prayers help us continue to grow!

Since our Auction last year, we've done great things! Here is what we have been able to accomplish financially:

- Our Fitness Path is complete! We raised over \$95,000 to make this project possible. Students, parishioners, community members and even the deer have enjoyed it. We held our first Halloween parade around it last week. The kids loved being able to wear their costumes at school.
- Sixteen security cameras were installed to monitor the interior and exterior areas of the campus to provide additional levels of security.
- Zaven Mouradian was hired as a Youth Minister and has already built a successful and fun Middle School program.
- We remodeled a classroom with new carpet, window coverings, paint and furniture! Stay tuned tonight for more information on how we hope to expand this project!
- New Ascension Press Adventure Bibles were purchased and donated for our Middle School students.
- We purchased a new science curriculum, which includes text books and digital access for our 5th - 8th grade students.
- A digital card catalogue was purchased and the media center is being re-organized to allow students and teachers to easily check out and search our books. Over \$1000 worth of new books have been added to the library.
- New this year, our middle school students attended a Fall Team-Building retreat at BattleGR. This was a fun day for all - I think they enjoyed watching their teachers participate in all of the activities the most.

There are certainly things I have missed, but we are continually looking for ways enhance our programming, while living out our Mission. Enjoy your evening, introduce yourself to someone you don't know and in the words of Father Mark "Bid HIGH and OFTEN!"

AUCTION INFORMATION

Grab a refreshment and walk around to check out the Silent Auction tables, Special Events, and do NOT miss the opportunity to get in on great raffles and prizes. If you have any questions, please see any one of our auction staff or an auction volunteer!

Review the lists and descriptions of items and services found in the catalogue and on our Auction Website. You will find Live Auction and Special Event descriptions in the catalog. Silent Auction items are listed, but for full details see the online bidding website and the item in person on its respective table. The auction paddle you received, as well as your name tag, has your bid number printed on it. Use this number for all of your bidding the entire night. Know what you are bidding on! The auction guidelines provide pertinent information for you. Use your bid number to purchase Special Events tickets/chance and raffles. No cash is necessary – see **the Check Out Procedure details**.

LIVE/SILENT AUCTION RULES

1. The LIVE auction will begin at 7:00 PM on November 11, 2023, and continue until all items have been auctioned. Doors will open at 5:00 PM for cocktails and to provide a time to view/inspect the various items up for bid. SILENT auction will begin prior to our event, but all closings are listed in this catalogue.
2. The successful bidder will be charged for all items purchased during the evening of the auction. Statements will be emailed within 3-7 business days after auction. Bidders have until close of the business day on Monday, November 20th to discuss their charges with the business office. Bidders may pay their bill by cash, check, MasterCard, Visa, or American Express to the parish office during normal business hours. If one of these payment methods is not used, the credit card obtained at check-in will be billed accordingly on Tuesday, November 21st.
3. A signature or oral bid constitutes a legal contract to buy. All sales are final and there will be no exchanges or refunds on items except when explicitly specified.
4. During the Live Auction bidders must hold up their bidding numbers to signify their bid. The Auctioneer will determine the highest acceptable bid.
5. Successful bidders must sign an "Auction Receipt". Individuals should verify that the bid number, amount of bid, and description of the item are correct before signing. By signing, you are in agreement with the information.
6. Items should be removed that evening by showing a valid ID & signing for the item.
7. Any values set forth opposite items being auctioned are often donors' estimates and are not warranted by the auction for tax purposes or for general use.
8. Some items may be "upgraded" through the donor/supplier. All upgrades will be based on the stated "retail" value of the item. Bidders will receive no credit for payments made to the auction in excess of retail when seeking an upgrade.
9. Unless otherwise specified, all auctioned items and services must be used within one year after November 11, 2023. Offers from donors will expire on November 11, 2024.
10. All auction items must be removed by the purchasers at their own expense from West Catholic High School or St. Anthony of Padua on Sunday, November 12, 2023.
11. The St. Anthony of Padua Auction Committee makes no expressed or implied warranties on auction items other than those from the manufacturer, which may be with the purchase.
